

LE ESTCWÉÝ PROTOCOL

All ceremony requests will be directed to Tk'emlups te Secwépemc Language and Culture Department with completed "Ceremony Planning Information" sheet

Upon approval of request, your group will meet at the Secwepemc Museum and Heritage
Park (TTeS) at your specified date and time

Follow Covid-19 safe protocols including use of Personal Protective Equipment, physical distancing and hand hygiene

Please provide and/or organize your own Mental Health and Wellness Supports – to support your ceremony

Please provide and/or organize your own Cultural or Traditional Supports – to support your Ceremony

Please provide your on medicines to be utilized for the ceremony

The use of technology to capture photos, videos, or other recordings is prohibited at the site

Be escorted to site by Language and Culture Department Staff and remain in area defined by Tk'emlups te Secwepemc

Conduct ceremony on MATT to ensure the sight and evidence is not disturbed

Do not leave anything near the site (memorial items may be left at the monument)

Put tissues in container provided so that we can burn them in respect of our ceremony protocols

Upon completion of ceremony, Rose Water (may or maynot) be available to brush off as you leave the Sacred Burial Site pending our current supply
