**All ceremony requests will be directed to Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc Language and Culture Department with completed "Ceremony Planning Information" sheet**

**Upon approval of request, your group will meet at the Secwepemc Museum and Heritage Park (TTeS) at your specified date and time**

**Follow Covid-19 safe protocols including use of Personal Protective Equipment, physical distancing and hand hygiene**

**Please provide and/or organize your own Mental Health and Wellness Supports – to support your ceremony**

**Please provide and/or organize your own Cultural or Traditional Supports – to support your Ceremony**

**Please provide your on medicines to be utilized for the ceremony**

**The use of technology to capture photos, videos, or other recordings is prohibited at the site**

**Be escorted to site by Language and Culture Department Staff and remain in area defined by Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc**

**Conduct ceremony on MATT to ensure the sight and evidence is not disturbed**

**Do not leave anything near the site (memorial items may be left at the monument)**

**Put tissues in container provided so that we can burn them in respect of our ceremony protocols**

**Upon completion of ceremony, Rose Water (may or maynot) be available to brush off as you leave the Sacred Burial Site pending our current supply**
