**Code of Conduct: This is a peaceful activity:** There is no tolerance for violent behaviour, destruction of property, or acts of aggression towards anyone. We will not bring weapons, or abuse drugs or alcohol.

**This is a respectful action.** We respect the values of non-violence & will show compassion to others & this place. This includes forestry workers & the RCMP.

We take responsibility for our own needs, physical & mental, with respect for the collective.

We respect and acknowledge the inseparable relationship that the Sinixt, Ktunaxa, Secwepemc, Syilx First Nations have with the land on which the camps are located. We expect visitors to the camps to recognize and affirm the rights and title of Sinixt, Ktunaxa, Secwepemc, Syilx First Nations, and to act with a high level of respect.

Come prepared to be self-sufficient, with camping equipment, food, water, foul weather gear. It gets cold up there at night, so bring appropriate layers.

-Leave no trace. Take out your garbage that you bring in, pick up anyone's garbage that you see. Cigarette butts are litter and a fire hazard.

-Human and dog feces are to be invisible, pick it up or bury it well.

-Because of the extreme fire hazard, please no smoking or campfires.

This is an action camp. Come with clear intent, willingness to help, and a clear mind.

**THERE IS NO CELL SERVICE. 100+ km North of Revelstoke. Fill your gas tank.**

**IMPORTANT:** Join us at km 2 on the Big Mouth FSR (approx. 122km up Highway 23N)

Once at camp, you will have a more thorough orientation.

There are a variety of jobs at the camp. At the orientation you will learn more, be prepared to tell us your skill set: first aid, media, photography, anything and everything that may be of aid.
