NO GAS SALES AT QUILAKWA CENTRE ESSO, STARTING OCTOBER 3

NEW CONSTRUCTION EXPECTED TO LAST 6-8 WEEKS

Enderby, BC – Quilakwa Investments Ltd. has announced the construction of a new gas station canopy at the Quilakwa Centre Esso, which will commence on Monday, October 3. As a result, no gas sales will be available at the gas station for the construction period, which is expected to last 6-8 weeks.

The Quilakwa Centre Esso store, car wash, and Tim Horton's restaurant and drive-thru will remain open for business during regular business hours: from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m., 7 days per week.

While the gas station parking lot will be obstructed, patrons may enter off 97A or Canyon Road. To exit the premises, traffic may be routed through the Canyon Road exit back onto the highway. Visitors are asked to please obey all signage.

Quilakwa Investments Ltd. apologizes for any inconvenience this construction may cause. However, the group is extremely excited for these upgrades to be completed and is confident that customers will be thrilled with the finished product.

Located at 5655 Highway 97A in Enderby, BC, Quilakwa Centre is a full-service gas station, which includes a convenience store, car wash and an Indigenous artisan gallery. This was the first service station ever constructed on a First Nations' Reserve.
