#### Company Background

The Splatsin are the most southern tribe of the Shuswap Nation, the largest Interior Salish speaking First Nation in Canada whose aboriginal territory stretches from the BC/Alberta border near the Yellowhead Pass to the plateau west of the Fraser River, southeast to the Arrow Lakes and to the upper reaches of the Columbia River. Shihiya School is currently recruiting **Certified Teachers on Call (TOC)** to join our team of professionals.

#### Position Purpose

Certified Teachers on Call (TOC) are primarily responsible for following the lesson plans already created by the regular Teacher and managing classroom environments. In addition to instruction, a Certified Teacher on Call (TOC) monitors and reports on student behavior and maintains a positive learning environment where all students are encouraged to participate, ask questions and generally receive the individual attention they need to effectively learn the material in the lesson plan.
