About the Contest

Students can learn how to prevent painful burns and scalds and what to do if they get burned by creating an educational burn awareness poster! The Poster Contest is fun and easy and student posters can be used to teach others about how to prevent burns and scalds. Remember to include Elders and families!

Contest Rules & Prizes

The rules are simple and all students in kindergarten through to grade 12 can enter!

- 1. Ask students to draw an original poster on an 8 ½ x 11-inch piece of white paper. Posters should illustrate how to prevent or treat a burn or scald. Students can use crayons, pencil crayons, paints...whatever is available.
- 2. Submit posters to the contest (see submission details below). Please make sure each poster has the student's name, school, and grade on the back.
- 3. All posters will be reviewed and judged on their messaging and creativity.
- 4. One winning poster per grade will be selected to receive a \$50 VISA gift card!
