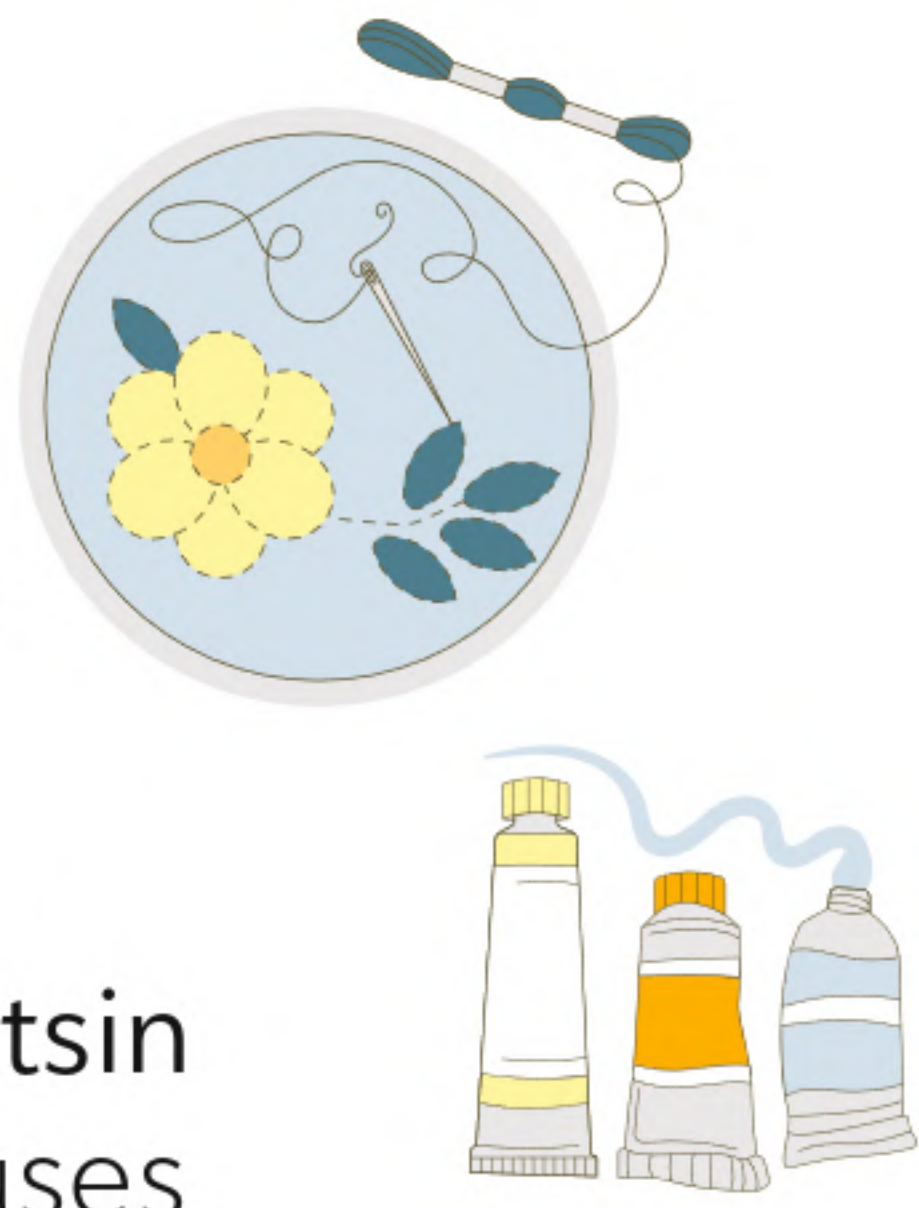

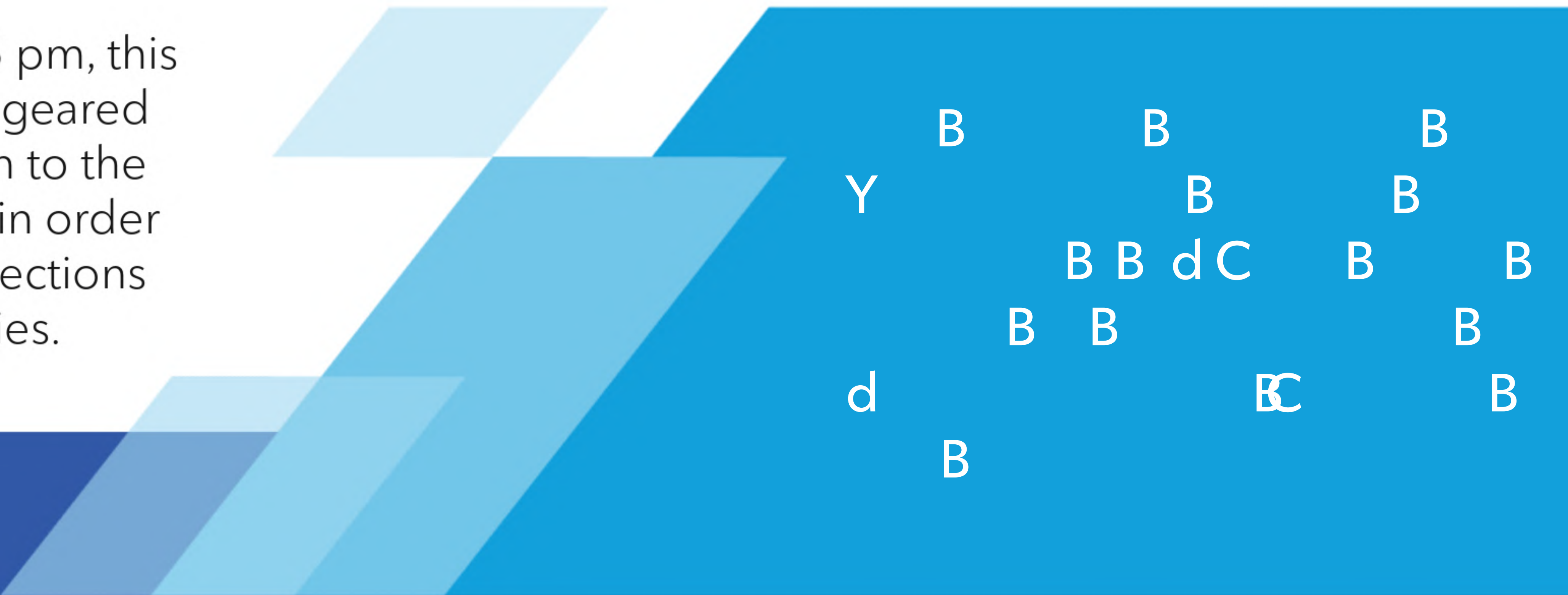

Fires and Low waters have postponed and canceled several attempts to set gill nets for harvesting Chinook from Mara Lake and the Lower Shuswap River this season.

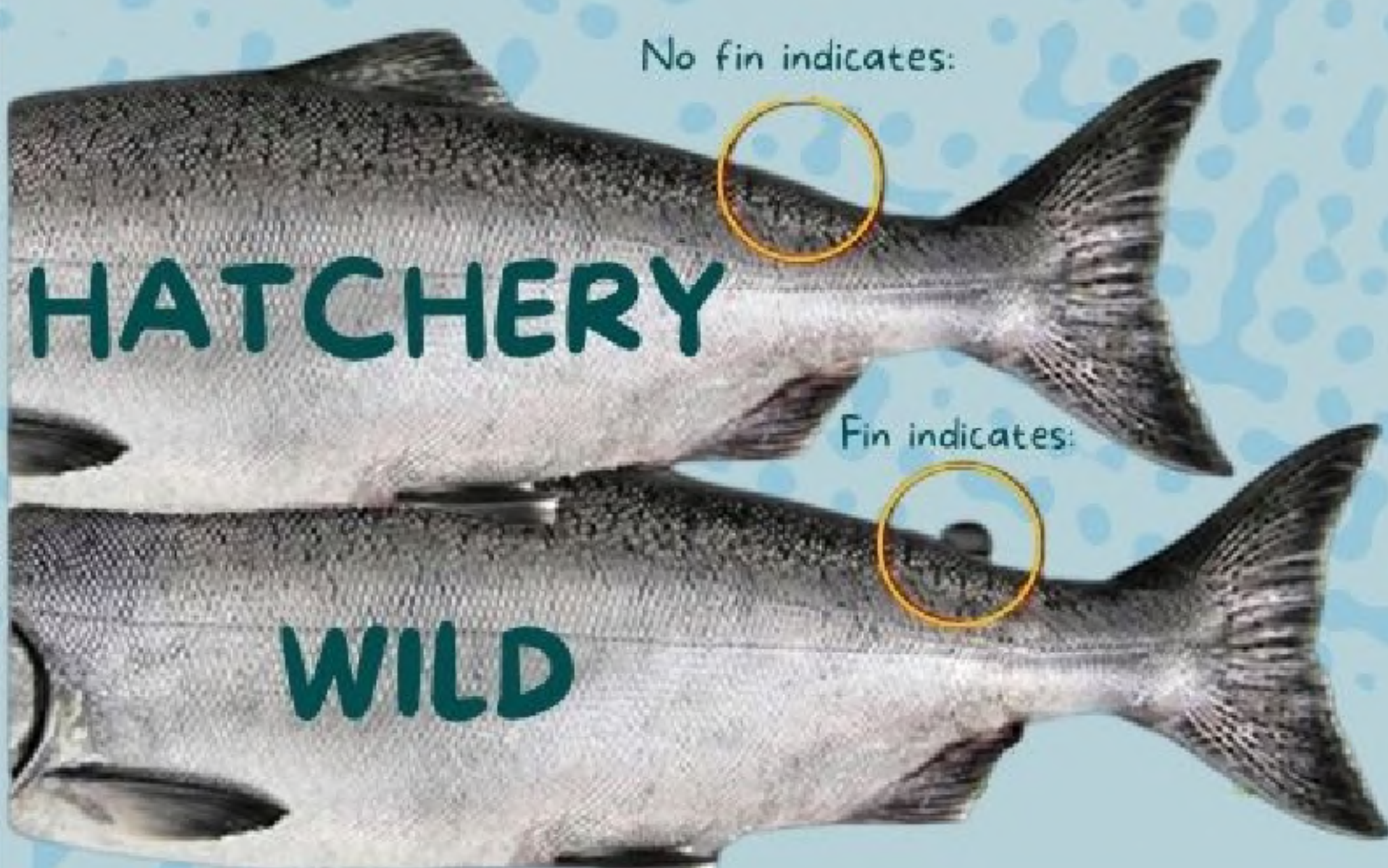

The Monashee Community Forest is accepting tenders for conventional roadside harvesting, and road construction contractors. This cutting permit (CP BB 2023) has an estimated volume of 17,001 m³, approximately 2.3 kms of road to be constructed, and approximately 5.7 kms of permanent road to be upgraded and/or maintained on Vance and Moonshine FSR's.



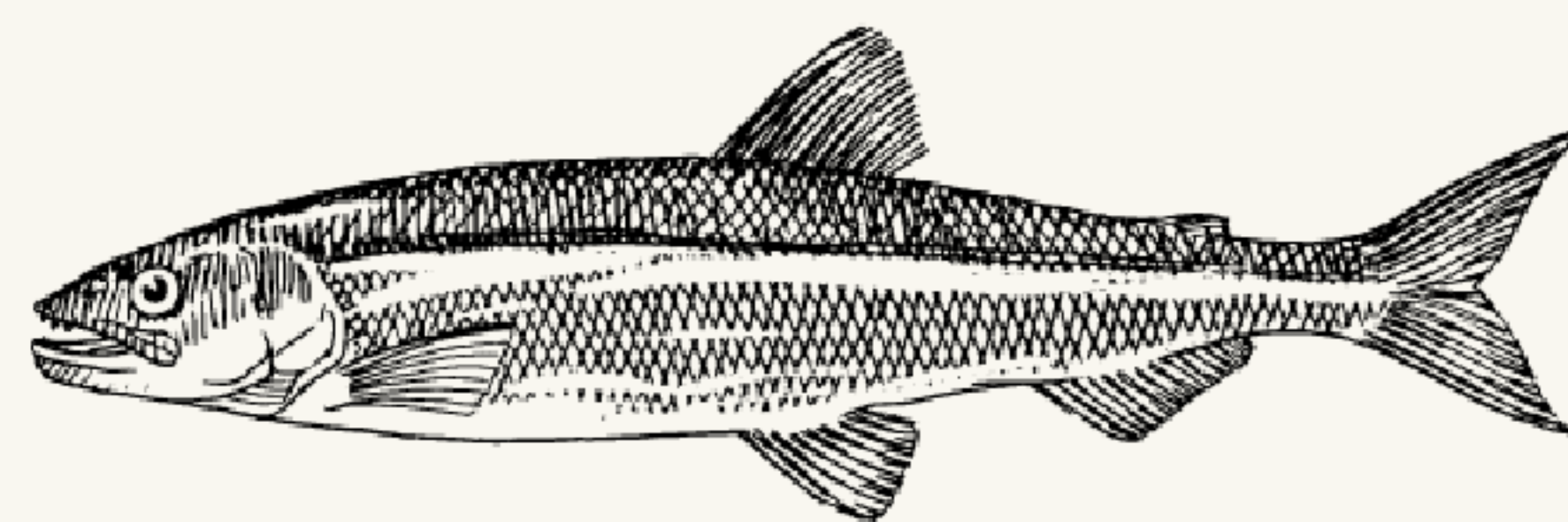
