



WHAT TO DO IF AN EMERGENCY HAPPENS

WHO TO CONTACT AND WHAT TO DO

- Any form of disaster or emergency that presents an imminent risk to public safety:
CALL 9-1-1
- Any incidents or disaster spotted that does not present an imminent risk to public safety or the environment, please contact Splatsin Emergency Program Coordinator by calling **(250) 241-1102** or **(416) 990-2959**.
- If a fire is spotted, you can notify BC Wildfire by calling ***5555** or **1 (800) 663-5555**.

WHERE TO GO

After calling Splatsin Emergency Coordinator and reporting the threat, proceed to a muster station: located at either the Splatsin Community Centre or the Splatsin Band Office. The Emergency Coordinator will meet you at the muster station or communicate the next steps by telephone.
