WILSEY DAM FIELD TRIP

Splatsin Title and Rights led a rafting trip down the Middle Shuswap River below the Wilsey dam and a tour of the Shuswap River Hatchery. This was an opportunity to be present and connect with the area. The view here is a short, uphill walk from the parking lot on the North side of the river.

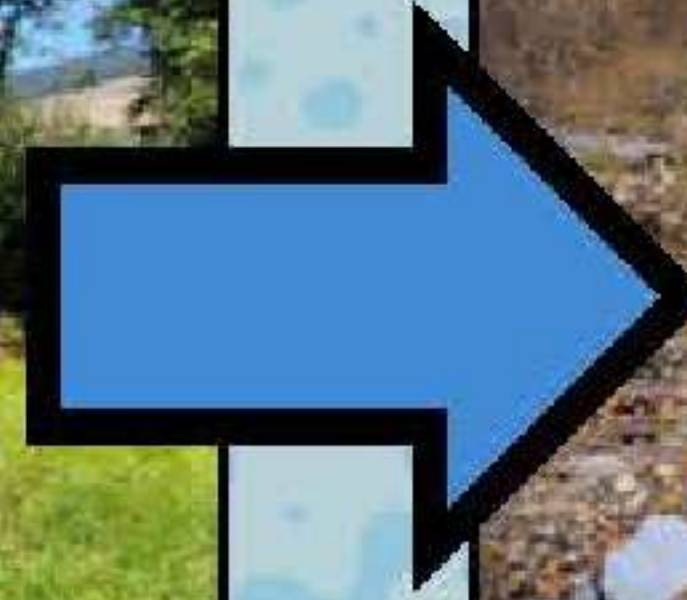
CHINOOK STREAMWALKS

Yuc crews are out on the river taking biological samples from dead Chinook to assess the number and quality of the spawning fish in the Lower Shuswap River. Next, they will be counting Coho at the Eagle River Fish Fence



FISH HABITAT & RESTORATION

Yucwmenlucwu began protections and restoration of a newly formed off-channel juvenile salmonid rearing habitat on Duteau Creek in Lumby this summer. The works, including partially removing fish passage barriers, is nearly complete and the area surrounding the bank stabilized area is being replanted with native trees and seeds.



The bank was stabilized with a liner and rock barrier and new native trees were planted to provide structure for the bank. We look forward to these trees and seed taking root and checking in on their growth next year!

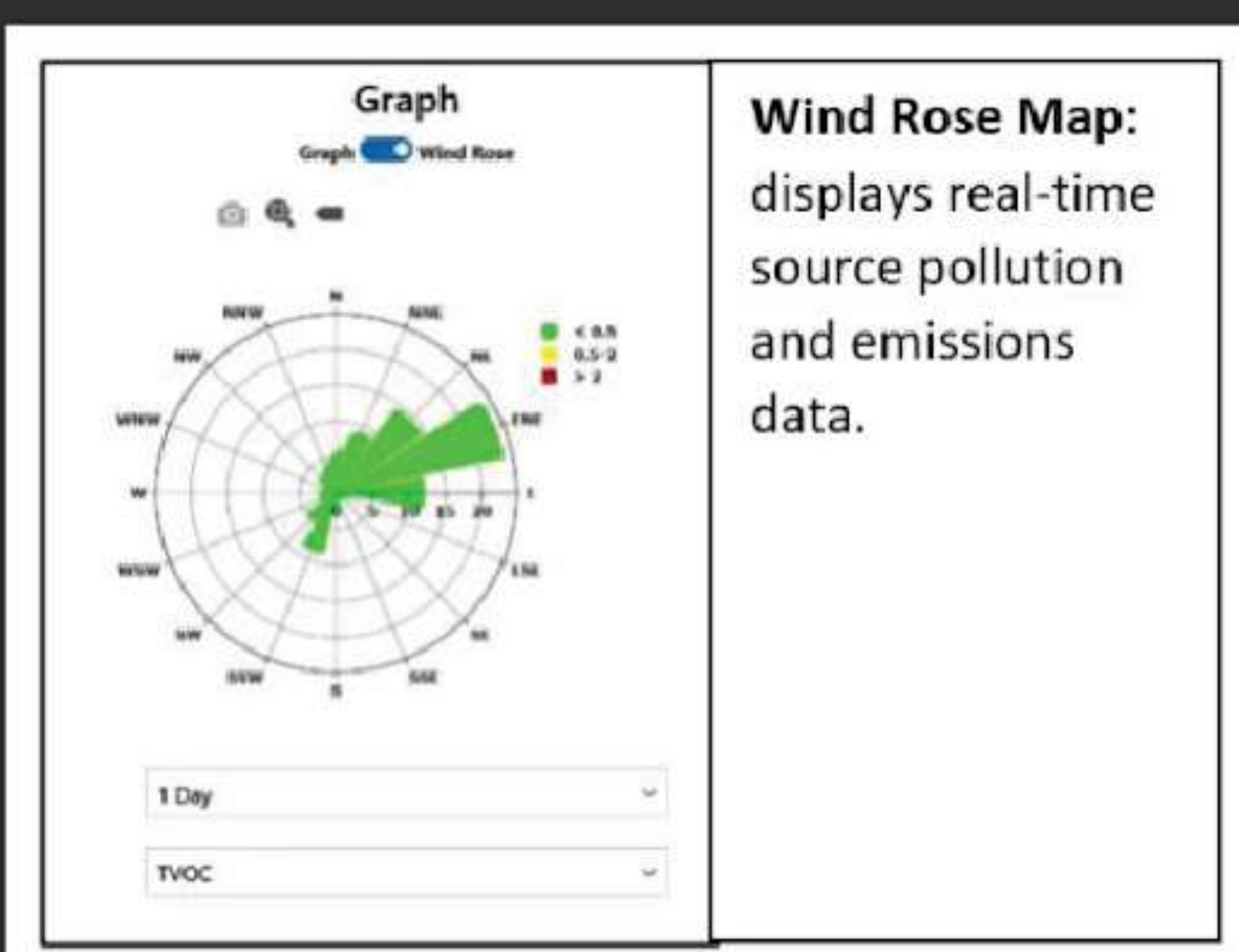

Air Quality Monitoring Stations

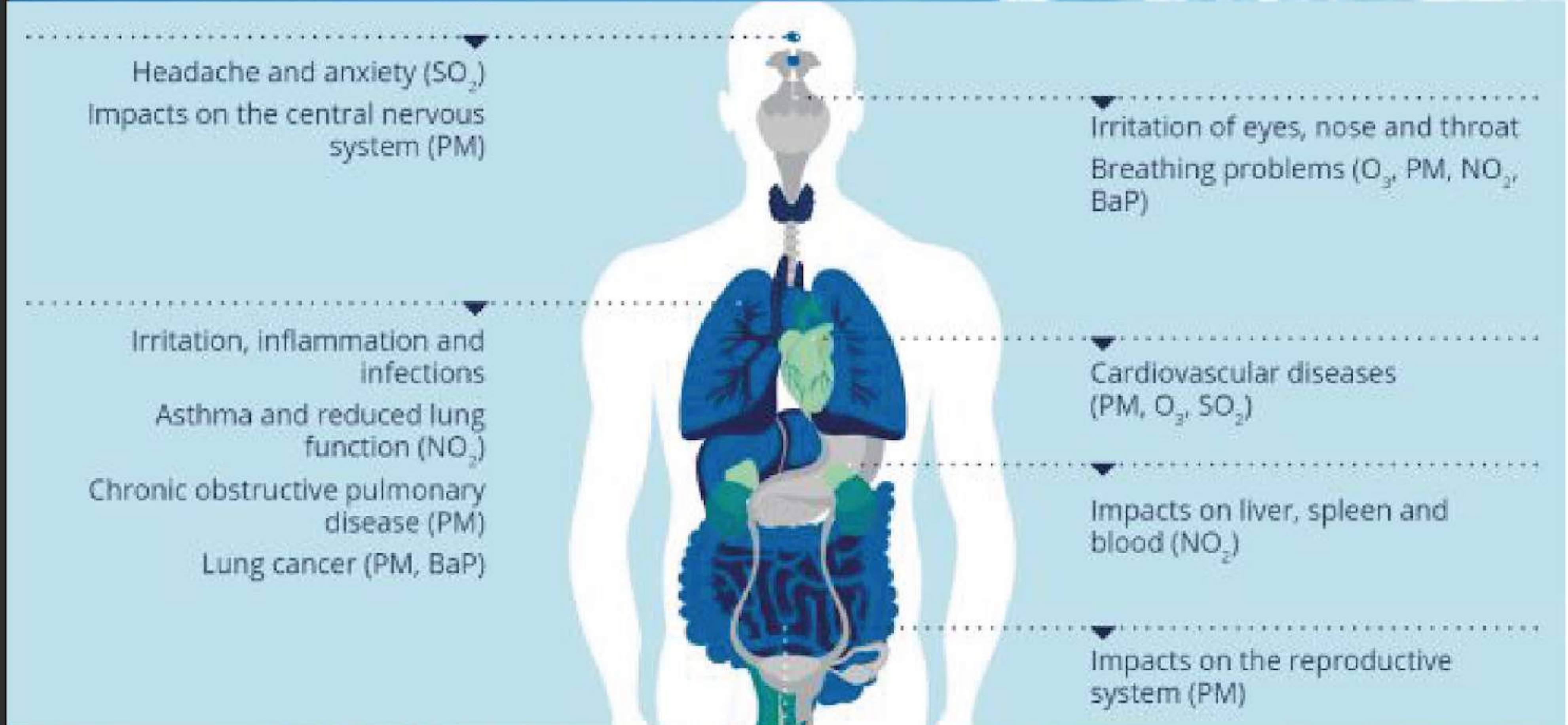
Clean air is important for the well-being of all life. Wildfire smoke, traffic emissions, and other types of air pollution can impact our health and quality of life including our ability to breathe normally, our nervous systems, create anxiety and cause headaches, irritate eyes, noses and throats, impact our livers, spleens and blood, and also our cardiovascular systems.

To better understand changes in the climate and surrounding outdoor air quality, Splat'sin Title & Rights in partnership with the Splat'sin Health Department and Yucwmenlúcwu, are installing three air quality monitoring stations that measure the weather and levels of potential air pollution. The information being collected will fill an important gap of environmental health information for this area and the community. Real-time air quality information from these monitors will be available once the monitors have been successfully installed. More details on this to come!
