Send any recent address updates to receptionist@splatsin.ca by December 1, 2023. Cheques will be mailed out on December 14, 2023.

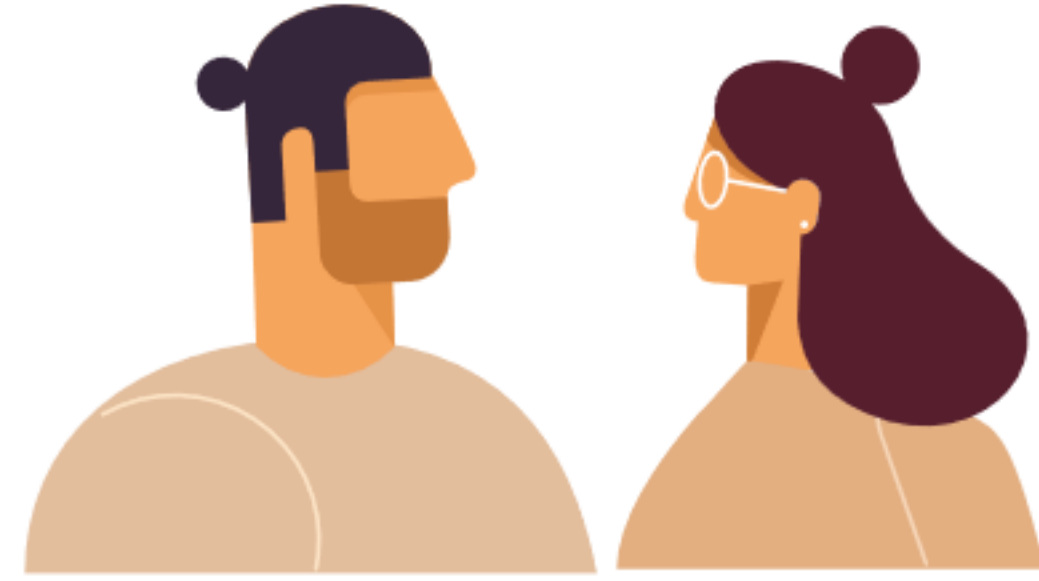

Main reception at (250) 838-6496 will continue to be able to transfer to each direct line. Please allow for extra response time during this transition period.

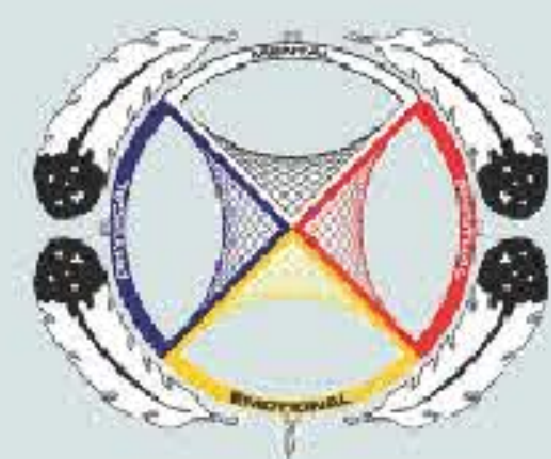
