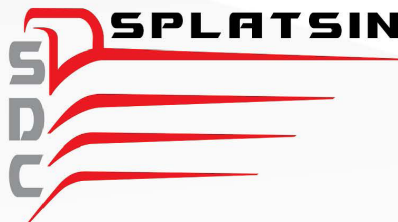

Whether your family is enjoying a wonderful camping trip, a hike up Enderby cliffs, finding a good patch of berries and/or medicine, or practicing your rights, this is your chance to share. Our goal is to showcase our Splatsin members practicing their rights and being present on Tmicw.

One community member (randomly chosen) will have the chance to win a monthly prize! One entry per person but you can upload as many pictures as you want!

Using the hashtag **#splatsintmicw** or by emailing **ash_simpson@splatsin.ca** you can upload a selfie, landscape, historic image, or images of important plants and medicines, etc.

We would love everyone to tell us about the image you choose and where you took it (approximate location is fine) so we have an idea where in Secwepemcúlecw you might have been. When submitting images please indicate if you give permission to Title & Rights for the purposes of sharing/using them for projects and newsletters.

Report Poaching, Polluting, and Dumping

While you're out on the land, if you witness anyone poaching, dumping garbage, harming fish and wildlife habitat, polluting and damaging the natural environment, or driving in road closure areas please report to the Conservation Officer 24 hr hotline 1 (877) 952-7277 (RAPP).

What to record if available:

- Description and number of people involved. Height, hair colour, etc.
- Details of violation
- Description of vehicle and license plate
- List of witnesses



If you witness fisheries violations related to salmon, contact Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) at 1 (800) 465-4336.

Please remember not to confront or approach the violators and instead report incidents to the appropriate authorities.

Also, if you witness an animal collision or see a hit animal on the side of a road, please report to AIM Roads by calling 1 (866) 222-4204, so they can remove and dispose.
