The Splatsin are the most southern tribe of the Secwepemc Nation, the largest Interior Salish speaking First Nation in Canada whose Aboriginal territory stretches from the BC/Alberta border near the Yellowhead Pass to the plateau west of the Fraser River, southeast to the Arrow Lakes and to the upper reaches of the Columbia River. Shihiya School is currently recruiting a **Part-Time Bus Monitor** to join our team of professionals.

Position Purpose

The purpose of this position is to ensure the safety of Shihiya School students by:

- Assisting the driver to ensure students are abiding by safety rules and procedures.
- Knowing the route and remaining alert to monitor the welfare of passengers while on route.
- Communicates behavior problems and conditions of various stops with the driver.
