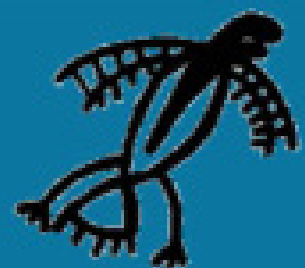
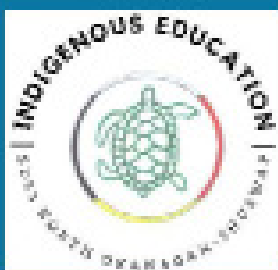

### SPLATSIN VOICE IN FISHERIES POLICIES

Fisheries and Oceans Canada is making changes to the Fish and Fish Habitat Protection Program in several waves. Yucwmenlucwu and a group of Splatsin fishers sat down in late February to discuss this. A technical memorandum was sent to DFO along with art made of the meeting by 4 talented community youth.



## COMING UP!

Yucwmenlucwu is working towards several initiatives in 2024 including:

- Salmon Habitat Enhancement and Bank Restoration
- Fisheries Streamwalks to count Chinook and Coho
- Fishing Catch Surveys and Fish Passage Barrier Removal
- Water Quality and Flow Monitoring
- Kokanee Spawner Counts and Lake Diversity Trawl
- Potential to expand fish harvesting and fish processing opportunities

## K4/5 Orientation Days

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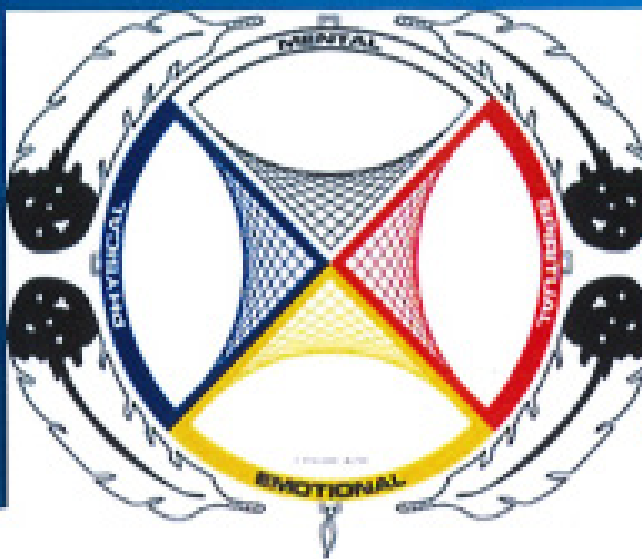
