

A technical memorandum was sent to DFO along with art made of the meeting by 4 talented community youth.

- Salmon Habitat Enhancement and Bank Restoration
- · Fisheries Streamwalks to count Chinook and Coho
- · Fishing Catch Surveys and Fish Passage Barrier Removal
- · Water Quality and Flow Monitoring
- Kokanee Spawner Counts and Lake Diversity Trawl
- Potential to expand fish harvesting and fish processing opportunities
