



Splitsin Stsmamlt Posting Family Support & Youth Worker

Position Purpose

The purpose of this position is to provide support to the Splitsin families and children in collaboration with Splitsin Stsmamlt Services. Assist in family preservation, reunification and provide positive development of Splitsin youth and families.

Position requirements:

- Provide family support and education in home
- Follow plans of care that's suited to each child's unique needs
- Provide youth support in promotion of healthy skills and positive behaviour management
- Provision parental visitation supervision
- Liaise with internal department and outside agencies when required
- Integrate Secwepemc/Splitsin culture and values in day-to-day practice
- Maintain caseload notes and all necessary paperwork

Qualifications:

- BSW, or another comparable certification, diploma or degree combined with at least two years' experience in the field of social work and working with youth.
- Experience in working with First Nations families and children
- Knowledge of First Nation issues and culture including communities, family structure, customs and traditions are essential
- Knowledge of Splitsin Community is valued
- Empathy with families and children experiencing problems and stress
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Strong Oral and written communication skills including listening skills
- Strong ability to build relationships and rapport
- High ethical standards
- Able to work with minimum supervision
- Strong computer skills including knowledge of MS Office
- Discrete and Respect for confidentiality is essential
- Valid Drivers License and clear abstract
- Clean Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector
